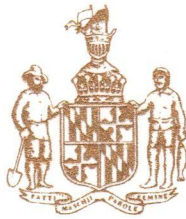

SENATE PRESIDENT MILLER ANNOUNCES COMMITTEE APPOINTMENT *Senator Delores Kelley to become Vice-Chair of Judicial Proceedings;*

Annapolis, MD – Senate President Thomas V. Mike Miller Jr., announced today the appointment of Senator Delores Kelley (D-10, Baltimore County), as a member and the Vice-Chair of the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee .

“As one of the sharpest minds in the Senate, I am excited to have Senator Kelley bring her talents and hardworking approach back to the Judicial Proceedings Committee,” stated Senate President Miller. “Senator Kelley’s expertise and commitment to an array of issues including juvenile justice, domestic violence, consumer protections, and sentencing policy will be a tremendous asset for the committee. Senator Kelley began her Senate service on the Judicial Proceedings Committee and she has remained active in areas of the Committee’s jurisdiction throughout her career. Among other roles, she has served as a member on: the Governor’s Task Force on Judicial Nominating Commissions; the Senate Special Committee Medical Malpractice Liability Insurance; the Family Violence Council; the Task Force on Common Ownership Communities; the Task Force to Study Identity Theft; and the Maryland Foreclosure Task Force.

Senator Kelley has been honored by numerous organizations for her work and dedication to these areas of public policy including receiving the Defender of the Defender Award from the Office of the Public Defender; the Legislator of the Year from the Domestic Violence Network of Maryland; The Champion for Children Award from the Maryland Foster Care Review Board; and the Annual Racial Justice Award from the YWCA of Greater Baltimore. She currently serves as one of the Senate representatives on the Maryland State Commission on Criminal Sentencing Policy, and has served on the Judicial Nominating Committee of the Legislative Black Caucus since 2001.
